Competition & Exhibition

*Celebrating Red Gums through the Arts
Sculptures will be exhibited amongst the red gums on the picturesque Settlers' Walk along the banks of the Wannon River.*

Sculptures can be sold (with %15 commission going to the Cavendish Red Gum Festival) **or** for exhibition/competition only.

All sale prices must be clearly stated on the entry form and on appropriate labelling with sculpture.

Outdoor Sculptures can be:

1. Anything *made of redgum* or
 2. *Made of anything and related to red gums, the red gum landscape or environment.*
- Creative interpretation of the theme is very welcome.

The Sculpture Walk will be open from Saturday 4th April 10-5pm and Sunday 5th 9-12noon

A prize will be awarded to "Best Sculpture" and "People's Choice"

Sculpture Exhibition Conditions of Entry

Please also read: **General Terms and Conditions ALL SECTIONS below**

- Entries can be made online via the Cavendish Red Gum Festival Website cavendishredgumfestival.com or by downloading and completing an application form and posting or returning it in person to "Tops & Tails" Brown Street Hamilton or the Cavendish Primary School Office. Hard copy forms are available, please contact us if required.
- Entry Forms **MUST** be submitted by **Friday 6th March 2020**
- Artists are able to submit one sculpture only.
- Works offered for exhibition must have the artist's name, title of work, medium and price (if for sale) marked clearly on a label affixed to the back of the work.
- All works must be made with/from red gum, or be representative of red gum in some way.
- Sculptures must be delivered and installed on **Friday 3rd April 2020 between 1pm and 3pm** other arrangements can be made by contacting us

Submissible Sculptures

- There is no minimum or maximum dimensions for sculptures providing the installed work permits appropriate viewing access, and presents no public safety or Occupational Health and Safety issues.
- PLEASE remember that sculptures will be outdoors.
- The Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee reserve the right to refuse applications/entries if they deem the work unsafe, unsuitable or inappropriate for public viewing.

Sculpture Installation Requirements:

- Sculptures must be delivered and ready to install on **Friday 3rd April between 1pm & 3pm. Alternative arrangements can be made by contacting us.**
- A label will be generated from your entry form so please ensure the name of your sculpture is there.
- The artist is responsible for all work related to the installations of their sculptures.
- All sculptures must be stable and adequately attached to stands/plinths/bases- which in turn must be appropriately weighted/secured to the ground- to minimise damage from human intervention and/or inclement weather.
- In the case of very large works some mechanical assistance may be available. In all other cases artists must supply their own trolleys, moving equipment and levelling materials if required for installations.

Security and Insurance

- While all due reasonable care will be exercised to ensure the security, safety and integrity of the sculptures during the competition and exhibition period. Sculptures are exhibited entirely at the artist's individual risk and no responsibility or insurance against theft, loss or damage, however caused is assumed or provided by the Cavendish Red Gum Festival.
- Artists are reminded that being an outdoor exhibition they may require or choose their own insurance to cover theft, loss or damage-either through human intervention or inclement weather-to their sculpture as well as legal claims against negligence on their part.

De-installation and Collection of Works.

Sculptures will be available for collection at the time specified by The Festival Committee. **Either after 5pm on Saturday 14th or after 12 on Sunday 5th April.**

- All materials used for installation must be removed from site on time of collection.

General Terms and Conditions ALL SECTIONS Art Gallery, Student Gallery, Photography and Sculpture.

1. The Cavendish Red Gum Festival will retain a commission of 15% of the sale price of all works/goods sold during, or as a result of, The Cavendish Red Gum Festival (not applicable for student entries)
2. To receive payment for sold work/goods all artists/suppliers must provide an ABN number or complete a tax declaration form.
3. All entries must be the original work of the named entrant.
4. The Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee will have the final say in where works will be displayed and these works will, under no circumstances, be moved throughout the duration of The Cavendish Red Gum Festival.
5. Images of artworks/sculptures/photography may be used on the Festival's social media channels and/or for promotion of the Cavendish Red Gum Festival.
6. Delivery - works are to be delivered to the appropriate venue at the set time. Works/goods cannot be accepted at any other time. All works/goods must be signed in by both the artist/supplier and the Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee
7. Collection - all unsold works/goods are to be collected at the set times ONLY. The Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee will not be responsible for any uncollected works/goods still at the venues once the set collection times close. All works/goods must be signed out by both the artist/supplier and the Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee.
8. The Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee will exercise all reasonable care, but will accept no responsibility for any direct or indirect loss, theft or damage of works/goods that form part the gallery, the children's gallery, the photo or sculpture exhibition.
9. The Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee reserves the right not to exhibit any works/goods that it deems inappropriate.
10. It is the responsibility of the artist/supplier to ensure all works that form part of the gallery, sculpture and photography exhibition meet all conditions of entry.
11. The decision of the appointed judge (if applicable) is final and prizes will be awarded by the Cavendish Red Gum Festival Committee.
